



South Baltic Four Corners Declaration of future cooperation

At the 2018 South Baltic Four Corners meeting the four partner regions:


- Regional Municipality of Bornholm
- County District Vorpommern-Rügen
- Southeast Skåne Committee of Cooperation, SÖSK
- Municipality of Świnoujście

have agreed upon the following:


- the South Baltic Four Corners cooperation shall be continued through projects, mainly youth-oriented projects which have been given top priority by all partners,
- the partners agree to look for external sources of financing such as EU funds and programmes to continue their cooperation,
- the youth cooperation shall be continued even without EU money and for that purpose all corners agree to plan an equivalent of €2000 per year in their budgets,
- The former permanent Four Corners structure with a Steering Committee will be replaced by meetings for politicians from our Four Corners at our joint meetings. The politicians attended will be authorised to make decisions for the cooperation within the projects.
- each Corner shall appoint a coordinator who will assist in communication between Corners, organise meetings and projects, facilitate liaison between politicians and youth within their Corner, etc.
